
June 2022 compared with May 2022

Industrial production up by 0.7% in the euro area and by 0.6% in the EU

Up by 2.4% and 3.2% compared with June 2021

In June 2022, the seasonally adjusted industrial production rose by 0.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.6% in the **EU**, compared with May 2022, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In May 2022, industrial production increased by 2.1% in the **euro area** and by 1.9% in the **EU**.

In June 2022 compared with June 2021, industrial production increased by 2.4% in the **euro area** and by 3.2% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in June 2022, compared with May 2022, production of capital goods rose by 2.6% and energy by 0.6%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 0.1%, durable consumer goods by 0.6% and non-durable consumer goods by 3.2%.

In the **EU**, production of capital goods rose by 2.1% and energy by 0.7%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 0.3%, durable consumer goods by 1.1% and non-durable consumer goods by 2.3%.


Among Member States for which data are available, the highest monthly increases were registered in **Ireland** (+6.7%), **Malta** (+4.8%) and **Greece** (+3.4%). The largest decreases were observed in **Romania** (-3.9%), **Belgium** (-2.2%), **Italy** and **Latvia** (both -2.1%).

Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in June 2022, compared with June 2021, production of capital goods rose by 7.6%, durable consumer goods by 4.0% and energy remained stable at 0.0%, while production of intermediate goods fell by 0.5% and non-durable consumer goods by 1.1%.

In the **EU**, production of capital goods rose by 7.5%, non-durable consumer goods by 2.6%, durable consumer goods as well as energy by 2.4%, and production of intermediate goods remained stable at 0.0%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest annual increases were registered in **Ireland** (+25.4%), **Denmark** (+25.0%) and **Bulgaria** (+17.4%). The largest decreases were observed in **Belgium** (-11.6%), **Slovakia** (-5.7%) and **Romania** (-3.7%).



Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Cyprus has a derogation with respect to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of industrial production** measures the evolution of the volume of production for industry excluding construction, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 79/2022 of 13 July 2022, the monthly percentage change for May 2022 has been revised from +0.8% to +2.1% in the euro area and from +0.6% to +1.9% in the EU. The annual percentage changes remained unchanged at +1.6% in the euro area and at +2.7% in the EU.
